I am writing to request permission to conduct a research study at Fort Lee High School. I am currently enrolled in the Masters of Exercise Science program at Kean University in Union, New Jersey. I am in the process of writing my Masters thesis. The study is entitled The Effect of Yoga on Stress and Cyberbullying in the Female High School Student.

I hope that the school administration will allow me to recruit forty female students, grades nine through twelve, (two physical education classes), from Fort Lee High School to complete two surveys. 
