## EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Board reconvened into the Public Meeting at 7:28 p.m.

# REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

Mr. Rota reported that there were seven (7) HIB investigations. Three (3) were founded.

Mr. Rota thanked Mr. Berman for hosting the Board Meeting and welcomed him to introduce the Fort Lee School No. 3 presentation.

Mr. Berman gave some background on the collaboration between the Fort Lee High School Academy of Theater Arts and the School No. 3 Musical Theater program. Mrs. Etra and her students have worked with the School No. 3 students in producing a musical for the past four years. To date, they have performed Seussical the Musical, the Wizard of Oz, Bye Bye Birdie and this year, The Little Mermaid. Mr. Berman then introduced the cast of the Little Mermaid who performed several scenes from this year's show. After the performance, he thanked everyone involved, including the BOE and Mr. Rota for their ongoing support of this program.

Administrators and teachers from Schools No. 1 - 4, Middle School and the Fort Lee High School shared their respective proposed school goals aligned with district level goals.

Mrs. Han Silver introduced the student representative from the Fort Lee High School, sophomore, Yasmine Kahtane.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mrs. Romba shared that the 1<sup>st</sup> Coffee and Conversation is scheduled for April 9 at 7:00 p.m. in the Fort Lee High School Media Center.

Mr. DiMeglio shared that the Negotiations Committee met with the four finalists being considered to be named attorney for the district.

Mrs. Han Silver shared that the School Security Committee met before the meeting but Mr. Rubino had to leave and the report will be given at the next meeting.

Ms. Taylor shared the 2018 surplus per the 2018 audit as \$36,000.

Tyrene Gibson, parent of a former FLHS student, expressed her disappointment with the FLBOE.

Mrs. Tuck responded to Ms. Gibson's criticism.
