 - d. Call for a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum so interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting as to warrant such action; and
 - e. Waive these rules when necessary for the protection of privacy or the efficient administration of the Board's business.

- Volleyball payment is as follows: If a school has two gyms and frosh plays in one gym with one official, pay the varsity fee. If JV in second gym with one official, pay varsity fee \$73. If one official is used for frosh matches, the fee is \$73
- Wrestling: Tri meet with one official, host school pays \$84 x 3 (\$252). Quad with two officials, host school pays one official \$84 x 3 (\$252).
- Scrimmage Fees: Officials are paid fee per level. Varsity official Varsity fee, Sub-varsity official sub-varsity fee.

	WHEREAS, several local governmental units have collectively formed or are in the process ning a Joint Insurance Fund as such an entity is authorized and described in NJSA 40A:10-36 and the administrative regulations promulgated pursuant thereto and;
	WHEREAS, the GOVERNING BODY has agreed to become a member of the FUND in ance with and to the extent provided for in the bylaws of the FUND and in consideration of bligations and benefits to be shared by the membership of the FUND;
NOW	THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:
1.	The GOVERNING BODY accepts the FUND'S bylaws as approved and adopted and agrees to be bound by and to comply with each and every provision of the said bylaws and the pertinent statutes and Administrative Regulations pertaining to same and as set forth in the Risk Management Plan.
2.	The GOVERNING BODY agrees to participate in the FUND with respect to the types of insurance listed in the
3.	The GOVERNING BODY agrees to become a member of the FUND for an initial period of three (3) years, the commencement of which shall coincide with the effective date of the FUND'S operation and coverage, or the effective date of membership, whichever occurs later.
4.	The GOVERNING BODY certifies that it has never defaulted any claims if self-insured and has not been canceled for non-payment of insurance premiums for a period of at least two years prior to the date hereof.
