CALL TO ORDER BY THE PRESIDENT

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m. by Mrs. Han Silver.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

MOTION by Mrs. Morell, seconded by Mrs. Romba, at 6:49 p.m., to move into Executive Session.

MOTION carried unanimously upon voice vote, 9-0.

The Board reconvened into the Public Meeting at 7:35 p.m.

REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

Mr. Rota shared that there are no HIB investigations nor Fire, Security or Bus Drills to report.

Ms. Taylor shared that the State Treasurer's report paints a grim picture of the national and New Jersey state economy. Budgeted fy21 State Aid will be reduced. Districts will be asked to re-do budgets without the additional state aid (year over year) originally planned for. For Fort Lee, the additional State Aid was \$351,933 (10% of fy21 budgeted Aid. Ms. Taylor further shared that all economic indicators (unemployment, stock market, housing sales) point toward a recession (2 consecutive quarters of GDP decline) or worse. Ms. Taylor reported that the State's "rainy day fund" (surplus revenue fund) will be completely depleted and re-purposed to ensure a balanced

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budget for the period ending June 30, 2020. Ms. Taylor believes we are in for a tough year but with thoughtful and deliberate decision making based on the ever-changing information we have at hand, we will get through this.

Mr. Rota shared the Governor's recent orders permitting in-person graduations after July 6th consisting of only 25 individuals which would make it extremely challenging to organize excessive number of graduations. Mr. Rota shared there is a plan to have a virtual graduation.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mrs. Tuck shared that there was a Curriculum Committee meeting held on June 1st. The Committee discussed; 1) graduation plans; 2) extended school year will be virtual; 3) CARES Act and how Dr. Amato will be developing the budget; 4) racial injustice and social unrest throughout the country and how the District is working on providing resources and websites to share with the parents in order to navigate conversations with their children; 5) how this unrest relates to our curriculum, and 6) the work The Equity Team is doing.

Mrs. Han Silver shared there was a virtual Bergen County School Board Meeting last week. The Interim Executive County Superintendent was in attendance. All the Districts are pondering how graduations will be handled and what to anticipate regarding schools re-opening in September. Mr. Louis DeLisio's advice is to please be patient as we are all in this together and will get through it together.

10F SOUTH BERGEN REGION VII WORKERS COMPENSATION POOL RESOLUTION TO JOIN SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS, a number of boards of education in the state of New Jersey have joined together to form a Workers Compensation Pool as permitted by chapter 372 Laws of 1983 (40A:10-36) and;

WHEREAS, said Pool was approved to become operational by New Jersey Department of Insurance and the Department of Community Affairs and has been in operation since that date, and;

WHEREAS, the statutes and regulations governing the creation and operation of a Joint Insurance Fund contain elaborate restrictions and safeguards concerning the safe and efficient administration of the public interest entrusted to such a Fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the <u>Fort Lee Board of Education</u> do hereby agree to join the Fund subject only to the right to approve the initial assessment when the same is received from the Fund following processing of the application, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the <u>Fort Lee Board of Education</u> is applying to the Fund for the following types of coverages:

Workers' Compensation and Employer's Liability

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governing Body hereby adopts and approves of
