EXECUTIVE SESSION

MOTION by Mrs. Morell, seconded by Mr. Rubino, at 6:35 p.m., to move into Executive Session.

MOTION carried unanimously upon voice vote, 9-0.

The Board reconvened into the Public Meeting at 7:37 p.m.

REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

Mr. Rota shared that there was one (1) HIB investigation and it was unfounded.

Mr. Rota shared that the Fire and Security Drills have been posted for the Board's review.

Mr. Rota shared that today was the first day of combined cohorts, and very happy to report it was a very successful day and we are moving in a positive direction.

Mr. Rota shared that Pomptonian, our food service vendor, has been providing meals to many families in the community to include weekends and is happy to report the Board has agreed to

continue the food service to the community through the summer months.

Mr. Rota introduced Ms. Nina Anderson, Lewis F. Cole Middle School Art teacher, to present #UsvsHate artwork.

Ms. Anderson shared her student's art presentation. The Board members commended Ms. Anderson for her commitment and how she inspires her students to demonstrate such amazing artwork.

Mr. Rota then shared the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Teacher of the Year award was presented to Ms. Anderson for her exceptional commitment to teaching Americanism and patriotism to her students by promoting civic responsibility.

Mr. Rota shared that the Fort Lee Central Office has moved their offices and are now located at 231 Main Street, 3rd Floor of the parking deck in the middle of town. Ms. Taylor then announced that a Public Hearing is being held tonight between the Fort Lee Board of Education and the Parking Authority in the Borough of Fort Lee to lease the offices on the third floor of the Gunzter Lining Building. Ms. Taylor inquired if the Board Members and/or the public had any questions on the lease and no questions were asked.

Ms. Colbath shared the relocation of the Central Office is the reason why the public meeting is virtual tonight but the Board is very committed to having in-person public meetings going forward.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mrs. Han Silver shared that the Negotiations Committee met Thursday, March 11th, Friday, March 12th, and Monday, March 15th to conduct interviews with legal firms and provide a recommendation of legal firms to represent the Board as evidenced in Resolutions 5B and 6B on tonight's Agenda.

PUBLIC WORK SESSION

Mrs. Byers-Kang thanked Mr. Rota and collaboration of the Board Members for combining the cohorts.

Mrs. Han Silver asked for clarification of the version of the 2021 - 2022 District Calendar the Board is voting on tonight . Mr. Rota shared that the District Calendar is item #2CUR on the agenda and shared updates to the calendar. Board conversation ensued including clarification of the version of the calendar to be voted on tonight.

Ms. Stassou asked what dictates why some coaches get paid vs. volunteer coaches. Mr. Rota shared the budget for each sport determines the coaches that are paid.

Mr. Sarnoff expressed gratitude and appreciation for the Board's services and the law firm of Sciarrillo, Cornell, Merlino, McKeever & Osborne, LLC, Board Attorneys and Labor Attorneys, for their invaluable services over the past eight years.

Ms. Kotang, representing the Asian-American community of Fort Lee, expressed the community's deep sadness and anger regarding the inexcusable assaults on the community. Ms. Kotang shared the contributions the Asian-Americans have made historically up through the present that remain unrecognized. Ms. Kotang asked that the curriculum be re-evaluated to include these valuable and notable contributions.

A member of the public shared his comments regarding the 2021 – 2022 district calendar.

Mr. Rota and Ms. Colbath responded to the community members' comments.

2B WHEREAS, the Fort Lee Board of Education has received the Superintendent's report of **incident(s) of Harassment/Intimidation/Bullying ("HIB")** within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board has had the opportunity to review the Superintendent's recommendations with respect to the incident(s) of HIB.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board accepts the Superintendent's recommendations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:37-15(d), the Superintendent of Schools shall inform the applicable parents/guardians of the students involved in these incidents with the following information within five school (5) days of this Board meeting:

- 1. The nature of the investigation;
- 2. Whether the District found evidence of HIB;
- 3. Whether discipline was imposed;
- 4. Whether services were provided to address the incident of HIB.

WHEREAS, the Fort Lee Board of Education ("Board") is a municipal body properly organized and governed by N.J.S.A. 18A:1-1 et seq; and

WHEREAS, the Board is subject to the New Jersey Public School Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-1 et seq. ("PSCL"); and

WHEREAS, the PSCL specifically requires that the Board award construction contracts to the "lowest responsible bidder" for those contracts that exceed the bid threshold. See N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-5; and

WHEREAS, the requirement to utilize the "lowest responsible bidder" has caused Boards of Education in New Jersey to spend more than budgeted for certain Projects due to the filing of change orders, failure to timely complete the work and/or poor workmanship; and

WHEREAS, the problems identified herein cause Board's of Education to spend taxpayer dollars over and above the anticipated budgets for said Projects, and in some cases, forces the Board's to utilize funds from their regular operating budgets, thereby depriving students and staff of critical instructional resources, and

WHEREAS, the Board requests that the Legislature amend the PSCL in a way to save taxpayer dollars and to govern the selection of contractors for construction work in a more effective and cost efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey School Boards Association ("NJSBA") is an entity formed for the purpose of representing and lobbying on behalf of local Boards of Education including the Fort Lee Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, the Board seeks to have the NJSBA petition the New Jersey Legislature to amend the PSCL to address the problems that arise from the use of the "lowest responsible bidder"; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board hereby petitions the NJSBA to seek the amendment of these statutes prospectively; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board hereby authorizes the Board's Legislative Representative to present the within resolution to all persons vested with the authority to seek the desired result of a modification to the PSCL.

- **4B** THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fort Lee Board of Education approves the appointment of the law firm of Sciarrillo, Cornell, Merlino, McKeever & Osborne, LLC as Board Attorneys from March 23, 2021 through March 31, 2021.

- **WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:26-10.11, a public hearing was advertised to be held at the meeting of the Fort Lee Board of Education on March 22, 2021 regarding a lease by and between the Borough of Fort Lee Board of Education and the Parking Authority of the Borough of Fort Lee to lease the third floor in the Guntzer Liner Building located at 231 Main Street, in the Borough of Fort Lee, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the lease will be \$150,000 per year for the first two years, \$160,000 for the third year, and for the fourth year and each year thereafter until the expiration of the lease, February 28, 2031, the annual cost shall increase 2% above the previous year's annual cost and will be funded from the general operating budget of the Borough of Fort Lee Board of Education.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fort Lee Board of Education, upon recommendation of the Superintendent, approves a ten-year lease agreement with The Parking Authority of the Borough of Fort Lee, commencing on March 1, 2021 through February 28, 2031, for Board of Education District Offices located at the Third Floor Guntzer Liner Building, 231 Main Street, in the Borough of Fort Lee, New Jersey, as per the attached agreement and authorizes the Board Secretary to execute said agreement. Attachment: LEASE AGREEMENT - CO

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fort Lee Board of Education, upon recommendation of the Superintendent, authorizes the Board Secretary to advertise the General Education Preschool Lottery Program in all designated newspapers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fort Lee Board of Education approves the **tuition rates for the General Education Preschool Program** for the 2021-2022 school year as follows:

\$900.00 per month per student for full-day program

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fort Lee Board of Education, upon recommendation of the Superintendent, approves **Mindful Leadership Consulting**, **LLC for Substitute Administrator Consulting** at a per diem rate not to exceed \$350/day from March 23, 2021 through June 30, 2021.

VHEREAS, the South Bergen Jointure Commission ("SBJC") and the Fort Lee Board of Education ("the Board") are parties to a 2021-2022 agreement for SBJC, an approved Coordinated Transportation Service Agency, to coordinate transportation services for the Board's students; and

WHEREAS, due to the current public health emergency, school districts may be required to close for health-related reasons; and

WHEREAS, under N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-9, if a school district is subject to a health-related closure for a period longer than three consecutive school days, a jointure commission shall continue to make payments under the terms of a contract with a contracted service provider as if the school facilities remained open, and

WHEREAS, if there are health-related school closures, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-9, the SBJC will be obligated to continue payments to its transportation service providers during the 2021-2022 school year; and

WHEREAS, SBJC's commitment to continue payment to those contracted transportation service providers is contingent upon the Board's continued payment to SBJC; and

WHEREAS, the SBJC is desirous of amending the terms of the Agreement to memorialize the Board's responsibility to continue its payment obligations to the SBJC in the event of school closures due to health-related reasons to ensure full compliance with N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-9.

NOW, WHEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE as follows:

- 1. For the term of the 2021-2022 school year, if schools are closed and/or operating under virtual or remote instruction as a result of the current public health emergency, thereby not requiring transportation services for the Board's students, the Board shall continue to make payments under its Agreement with SBJC, as if the school facilities remained open, for SBJC to pay its contracted transportation service providers in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-9.
- 2. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement not addressed herein shall remain in full force and effect. *Attachment:* **SBJC AGREEMENT 2021-2022**

MOTION by Mrs. Romba, seconded by Mr. Rubino, that the Fort Lee Board of Education approves items #1F through #7F.
