Mrs. Han Silver expressed her displeasure of the rushed Board process to appoint the permanent Superintendent at tonight's meeting. Ms. Colbath detailed the Board's methodical Superintendent

search process and expressed the hiring of the Superintendent was not rushed and accomplished within the anticipated timeline.

Several members of the public shared their comments and concerns including: congratulating Mrs. Curry on her Board appointment; clarification of the hiring and funding of six new custodians; requests to hire an additional guidance counselor at the elementary level; clarification of Mr. Robert Kravitz' educational background and qualifications; dissatisfaction of the Superintendent hiring process; displeasure in not reinstating Mrs. Giacomelli; concerns about student desk shields impairing students' views of the [chalk/white] board. Ms. Colbath and Dr. Schoen addressed all guestions and comments.
