HEARING OF CITIZENS- QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

MOTION by Ms. Cho, seconded by Mrs. Richter, to open the floor to the public, 9:04 p.m.

MOTION carried unanimously upon voice vote, 8-0.

Victoria Kim talked about a stalking incident that happened that day (followed to her car with her child, told "Justice will be served" and given a look). She wants to make public record of the incident and requests proper protection of her child. She has concerns about the suitability of the School #1 principal after the July 20th PTA election, stating that 176 students were endangered and lost instruction time. She asked about the certification results and the process timeline. A board member responded that they don't discuss personnel matters in public as prohibited by law.

Christina Suh was disturbed by what happened to Victoria Kim. She asked why the Board is not allowed to discuss. She said Mrs. Giacomelli has been warned of abusive and inappropriate actions in 2012, 2015, 2017, and 2020. She said on 9/22 there were affirmative charges (mistreatment of parents from 2006 to present) from 42 parents and 34 teachers. She noted that these are not frivolous claims; but harassment and legitimate issues.
