PUBLIC WORK SESSION

Mr. Papavasiliou inquired about the handwritten changes on the Dobco payment application. Ms. Taylor shared that Turner, SSP and the Fort Lee Board of Education disagreed with certain costs on payment application #5. Dobco does not agree with our position but, in an effort to get the payment application into the Board on time for Board review and approval, Dobco agreed to the handwritten crossouts of the disagreed open items.

Mr. Surace highlighted that Dobco has 20% of the contracted payment and we do not have a building foundation.

Mr. Osso stated that when Dobco finishes the slab on grade pour, they will be erecting the steel.

Mr. Papavasiliou inquired why the percentage increase in sick and vacation compensation for Ms. Taylor's employment contract is 19.76%. Mr. Rota and Ms. Taylor surmised that the 2016-2017 number was based on the minimal accrued days in 2015-2016.
