**WHEREAS**, the Renovation of the Roof Repair at School No. 4 is other capital projects within the scope of the District's LRFP, which would otherwise be eligible for State support.

WHEREAS, the Board intends to transfer \$198,000 from its capital reserve to fund the total cost of the School No. 4 Roof Repair Project.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. The Board of Education hereby authorizes the use of capital reserve to fund the School No. 4 Roof Repair Project.
- The Board hereby approves the total transfer of \$198,000 for the School No. 4 Roof Repair Project from the capital reserve account to the capital outlay fund to fund the total costs, less any excess costs, of the School No. 4 Roof Repair Project.
