CALL TO ORDER BY THE PRESIDENT

The meeting was called to order at 6:45 p.m. by Mrs. Romba.

EXECUTIVE SESSION #1

MOTION by Mr. Sarnoff, seconded by Mrs. Morell, at 6:48 p.m., to move into Executive Session.

MOTION carried unanimously upon voice vote, 9-0.

The Board reconvened into the Public Meeting at 7:32 p.m.

REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

Mr. Rota reported that there were fourteen (14) investigations; eight (8) were founded.

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COMMITTEE REPORTS

Finance Committee – Mr. DiMeglio shared that the committee had their second budget meeting prior to today's public meeting.

Negotiations Committee – Mrs. Han Silver shared that the memorandum of agreement between the Board of Education and the Fort Lee Education Association is on today's agenda for approval. The two negotiation teams met last Monday until 2am but came to an agreement. Further, she confirmed that earlier this afternoon, the Association ratified the memorandum of agreement.

PUBLIC WORK SESSION

Mrs. Colbath inquired about the 2018-2019 proposed general education preschool program changes including number of students that will be participating, if all lotteried students will pay, and how the increased \$900 tuition rate was determined.

Mr. Rota referenced the 2/16/18 weekly board update report detailing the proposed program expansion from 9 students to 12 students, change from part-day to full-day program, and the Director of Special Services surrounding program tuition comparability survey.

Mrs. Colbath asks the benefit of Friday (2/15/19) in one week and Monday (2/18/19) in the following week as vacation days for the 2018-2019 District Calendar. Mrs. Colbath recommends vacation days of Monday (2/18/19) and Tuesday (2/19/19) for the 2018-2019 District Calendar.

Mr. Sarnoff congratulated the negotiations committee and administrators. Mrs. Colbath also thanked the negotiations committee and administrators and thanked Mrs. Han Silver for influencing negotiations to continue late Monday evening when talks were beginning to break down.

Mr. Rubino shares that school security will be reviewed and a report on any changes will be shared.

She further shared that they have met with the Mayor with the goal being a collaborative approach in light of school budget constraints. Ms. Ko-tang congratulated the Board on getting the contract settled.

Ms. Genevieve Callahan, employee, thanks the Board for settling the teacher's contract. Ms. Callahan shared that the feeling in the hallways is so much better and, again, thanked the Board for settling the contract.

Gun Control and Mental Health Services to Protect Our Youth

RESOLUTION

- **WHEREAS,** A prerequisite to student growth, learning, well-being and success is a safe and secure school environment; and
- **WHEREAS,** Children throughout the nation have been negatively affected directly and indirectly by violent crimes involving firearms; and
- **WHEREAS,** Military-style assault weapons and large-volume ammunition magazines were used in recent mass killings in schools and other locations; and
- **WHEREAS,** Profiles of school shooters illustrate the need for a thorough examination of the care and treatment of the mentally ill and for effective intervention;
- WHEREAS, The New Jersey School Boards Association's 2014 study, What Makes Schools Safe?, cited reports by state and federal agencies, which found that mental health intervention did not take place prior to three-quarters of school shootings; and
- WHEREAS, New Jersey has among the strongest gun control laws in the nation and the lowest incidence of gun-related deaths, but protective laws are not in place in many other states or at the federal level; and
- WHEREAS, The tragedies of Parkland, Florida, of Newtown, Connecticut, of Columbine High School in Colorado, emphasize the need to address access to firearms and the delivery of mental health services. Now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the Fort Lee Board of Education, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, urges President Trump and Congress to identify and implement meaningful action to address access to and ownership of military-style assault weapons and ammunition, the delivery of mental health services, and financial support to ensure a safe and secure school climate; and be it further
- **RESOLVED,** That the Fort Lee Board of Education supports Governor Murphy's call to end the "epidemic of gun violence that plagues far too many of our communities" and supports enhancements to state law that will provide protection for our schools and communities; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be sent to President Donald J. Trump, U.S. Senator Robert Menendez, U.S. Senator Cory A. Booker, U.S. Representative Congressman Bill Pascrell, Jr., Governor Philip D. Murphy, State Senator Loretta L. Weinberg, Assembly Representative Valerie Vainieri Huttle, Assembly Representative Gordon M. Johnson, the New Jersey School Boards Association, and the National School Boards Association.
